- Date: August 4 & 5, 12
- Display Times: Saturday (10 AM to 6 PM) and Sunday (10 AM to 5 PM)
- Location: Downtown Lexington, east of the light
- Security: Provided dusk until dawn.
- Set-Up: Before 9 AM on Saturday (8/4)
Early set up information will be available by July 10, 2012.
Assistance with set up is available if requested in advance.
- Fee: \$150 per site is non-refundable. Your canceled check is your confirmation/receipt. This is a juried show. Photos of original artwork and booth (maximum of 4) or CD must be sent in with your \$150 (non-refundable) application. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like your photos or CD returned.

Parking for artists is designated and will be monitored. Free shuttle service is available.

The committee also reserves the right to accept or decline any applicant and may remove all or part of an exhibit that it finds to be in violation of the rules.
Decisions of the jury are final.
Artist must be present both days.
